<p>2. Discussion of AB109</p>	<p><u>Chief Scray</u> - Legislation mandates an oversight community partnership committee to develop a local plan to present to Board of Supervisors. Legislation is specific on who sits on group.</p> <p>Today is Executive Committee's 1<sup>st</sup> meeting to ensure we meet requirements, everyone understands AB 109 and what it means to SB County, and assign a working group with members from various agencies.</p> <p>Current legislation changes daily and does not include District Attorney or Public Defender; addendum to add both offices.</p> <p><u>DA Ramos</u> – safety organization did not support AB109 and wrote letters re serious concern on limited jail space.</p> <p><u>Chief Scray</u> – Presented AB 109 powerpoint No state prison inmates will be transferred to county jails.</p>																

	<p>Even though “non-non-non” violent, they are still a safety risk to public. Does not include 3 strikes individuals.</p> <p>Cognitive based classes will be offered; challenge to change way parolees think.</p> <p>Parole At Large (PAL) – unknown how active team is.</p> <p>High recidivism rate of 67% for 2010; SB County can improve this percentage.</p> <p>SB County will be ahead of other counties, and we’ll probably be the model. SB County’s success is due to the collaboration among departments/agencies.</p> <p>Concern expressed re group homes. State has several contracts with group homes/residential facilities. These facilities are not licensed and not regulated. County would have no local control. Ex Committee recommended that Workgroup Committee fight back w/state. State not paying us for housing.</p> <p>*Taping of meeting on file.</p>
