Financial Report	Cheryl reported on current Budget/Year to date expenditures: Probation Department is at 87% spent. This does not include all of June costs. It appears that there will be no change in allocation this year. We are still waiting to hear from the State.	
Counseling & Tutoring Update	Director Ford stated that there are 22 counseling providers and 7 tutoring providers. Professional Tutors of America has been the most used because of their ability to work well with youth at risk. Director Ford along with John Greswit from Human Services has been conducting on site monitoring of the providers. On June 19 <sup>th</sup> , monitoring was completed at Learning Fundamentals in Hesperia. The purpose of the visit is to ensure all programs and systems comply with the contract. Mr. Greswit will be completing the monitoring report and will submit to Probation.	
School Probation Officers	The Board of Supervisors approved the school district contracts (14) on June 24 <sup>th</sup> .

They are in the process of updating their database to track students being served. The database should be ready by the beginning of the school year.
