Introductions & Opening Remarks	Meeting was called to order at 2:05pm.						
Review & Approval of Minutes	A motion to approve the minutes for October 21, 2014 made by Michael Dowd and seconded by Earl Smith; Minutes approved by all unanimously.						
Financial Report	Cheryl reported: Current fiscal year- 25% spent thus far. \$364,893.00 received in growth surplus money from the State. This was extra money not expected.						
Counseling & Tutoring Update	Director Ford handed out the Monitoring Criteria paperwork used during monitoring visits of Enrichment providers currently under contract with Probation. She stated that John Greswit from Human Services and herself have conducted site monitoring of the providers in the area. Once completed, Mr. Greswit will submit the monitoring report to Probation.						
School Probation Officers	Several Probation Officers and Correctional Officers attended trainings this quarter. They include: NCTI, SARB, Anti-Bullying, Parent Project, Girls Circle and Boys Council						
НАР	Director Ford reported that currently 1 Officer is monitoring at 15 to 30 minors; This exceeds the 15 to 1 ratio. After discussion between Chief Brown, Judge Marshall and Phyllis Morris regarding the status of this program, it has become imperative to assign 2 more PO's. Approximate cost for the positions will be about \$270,000. Funding will come out of the carryover until the budget item is presented to the Board.

Assistant Chief Fuzie recommends proposing the addition of 2 more officers to the HAP program. She explains that one officer is not enough to cover the region Probation supervises. A motion to authorize 2 new PO's. by Geoffrey Cant and seconded by Pam Schram. Motion approved unanimously. 	
L.E.T Update	Michael Dowd, Supervising Deputy District Attorney, informed the Council that there are currently 3 Deputy DA's to cover each region, 1 High Desert, 1 Rancho, 1 San Bernardino. His staff also includes 2 OA's assigned to the Unit. He reported that last school year there was an increase of students serviced by LET. A 3-6% jump per year, totaling about an 18-25% increase in four years. He went on to say there will be changes in legislature but the DA will work with them as best as they can. Bill passed requiring DA to report how many going through SARB.	Mr. Smith to give copy of county school district SARB reporting to DA Dowd.
