Collection of Forensic Evidence (Title 15, Section 1452; NCCHC)

703.1 PURPOSE:

To establish guidelines regarding ordered forensic evidence collections.

703.2 RESPONSIBILITIES:

- I. Medical Services shall:
 - A. Not participate in the collection of forensic evidence, including and not limited to the collection of blood samples, alcohol/drug toxicity levels, full body examinations, body cavity examinations, and DNA testing for the purpose of prosecution.
- II. <u>Watch Commander (WC)/ Probation Corrections Supervisor II (PCS II)/ or Designee shall:</u>
 - A. Refer to other outside contracted providers for forensic evidence collection orders.
