Victorville Compliance Operation Nets 19 Arrests

VICTORVILLE – The San Bernardino County Probation Department conducted a compliance operation on Wednesday to ensure those on probation were acting within their conditions of supervision.

The goal of this operation was to redirect technical violations of probation and arrest those who were substantially out of compliance. Resources and rehabilitative services were offered to those in need.

During the 8-hour operation, 59 home visits were conducted and 19 people were arrested. Officers confiscated 3.3 pounds of methamphetamine, as well as heroin, Fentanyl, and firearms. More than 50 law enforcement officers from the San Bernardino County Probation Department, the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department, and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation participated in the operation.

"These compliance operations are conducted to ensure that probationers are following their terms and conditions and that we are keeping the community safe," Chief Probation Officer Tracy Reece said.
